

137 - יהי רצון מלפני אבינו שבשמים, לרדם עלינו

We should merit to see in our days that our enemies will no longer be able to persecute us with death and destruction.

138 - יהי רצון מלפני אבינו שבשמים, לקים בנו חכמי ישראל

We desire that the Torah leaders of our generation and their Children and Students live amongst us in all our communities.

139 - יהי רצון מלפני אבינו שבשמים, שנשמע ונתבשר בשורות טובות

The unexpected news you hear should be good such as a person who finds out he is a Jew and is gathered with all the Jews to the Land of Israel.

140 - אדונו כל בית ישראל

When all the Children of Yisrael come together as brothers it will be the time for Hashem to redeem us speedily from our great oppression.

141 - ידללו את שם יי, כי נשגב שמו לברו

All rulers will give up their thrones, the arrogant will be humbled recognizing the truth of being powerless, exalting only the name of Hashem.

142 = לרוד מזמור

The honor of Hashem's Glory fills the entire world, the Gates to the Temple opened for the first time to publicize that David's sin was forgiven.

143 = ובגדה יאמר, שובה די רבבות אלפי ישראל

The presence of Hashem should rest permanently in the Temple amongst his nation with the garments of the Kohanim providing atonement an for our sins.

144 = מזמור לרוד הבו די בני אתם (Returning the Torah on Shabbos)

The Avos exhibited their great strength through Emunah, as Hashem's name is mentioned 18 times showing how we have to glorify and honor him.

145 = אשרי

One who uses all of his abilities for the sake of Heaven will receive special divine guidance and assistance.

146 = פותח את ירך

There is no such thing as a rich, happy or healthy person. There are only people who Hashem keeps rich, happy or healthy. (and these things can fade at any time)

147 = למנצח מזמור לרוד

This song illustrates how we can win favor in the eyes of Hashem through sincere prayer, repentance and good deeds nullifying evil decrees against us.

148 - ובא לציון

The saying of the Order of Kedusha raises Israel to the Heights of when the Bais Hamikdash stood which even the angels can't see or obtain.

149 - עלינו

Yehoshua circled the impenetrable walls of Jericho which miraculously fell. Greater recognition of Hashem causes Him to do even more Good to Yisrael.

150 - לרוד מזמור 24

David wrote this on the day he bought the land to build the Temple. Serving Hashem requires total dedication as much intensity is needed to succeed.
