- Art Journal (mixed media)
- Black sharpie fine tip, waterproof
- Pencils, pencil crayons, markers of your choice

Watercolor Paints

- Any type of watercolor paint works well. I really like my Brusho Crystals

Acrylic Paints

- I like using Liquitex Basics. You can get them in heavy body, or opaque. The heavy body are usually more expensive. I have starred the ones I would begin with. Buying paint for me is kind of like walking into a bookstore. I never leave with my hands empty. My favorite colors are:
 - Titanium White *
 - Mars black, and also Paynes Grey *
 - Burnt Umber (brown) *
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium *
 - Quinacridone Magenta *
 - Phthalocyanine Blue *
 - Dioxazine Purple
 - Prism Violet *

- o Bright Yellow Green
- o Turquoise
- Other great colors are Chromium Oxide Green, Hookers Green, Burnt Sienna, Bright Aqua Green, Cadmium Orange (very expensive), yellow oxide.

Paintbrushes

- I like to have a 1", ½", ¼" and a fine brush.
- Everyone has a different view on brushes. Mine are soft brushes and I have seen them at Micheal's. They are clear handled.
