

# The Kerrie Hess Beginner Course in Abstract Art



## Materials - Need to have vs. nice to have

### Need to have:

- A plastic tarp/sheet to lay over your table
- Four basic paintbrushes (large filbert, smaller filbert, rounded brush, pointed round brush, larger brush for large canvases)
- Basic primary colours - Red, Blue, Yellow (250ml or above)
- Basic black paint (100ml or above)
- Basic white paint (500ml or above)
- Impasto Medium (250ml or above)
- White Acrylic Gesso (200ml or above)
- Simple jar for water & cleaning brushes
- 5 or 6 plastic or porcelain containers
- 2x plastic paint palette
- 1x Palette knife with pointed tip
- 1x Palette knife with rounded tip
- Basic spray gun to fill with water (to preserve your leftover acrylic paint)
- 3 or 4 basic facecloths
- Gold Leaf & Gold Size glue
- Any basic flat brush for removing gold leaf
- Masking tape
- 3 small canvases (12\*12 inches or similar)
- 3 medium canvases (14\*14 inches or similar)
- 3 large canvases:  
**2x** 24\*30 inches or similar  
**1x** 30\*40 inches or similar

Keep in mind any of the lessons can be done on any size canvas - these sizes are suggested to help you ease into painting on canvas. If you are painting for a specific place in your home, change the size of the canvas to suit!

### Nice to have:

- Liquefying medium (100ml or above)
