## SEMESTER OVERVIEW

During the first semester you will study Old Testament Law and History. You will do an in-depth study of Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, and Joshua. You will also begin your personal reading through the Bible.

### PERSONAL

Begin reading through the Bible, starting in Genesis. There is no requirement for how much you read during the first semester, the goal is that you have read through the entire Bible upon completion of the course. You may get ahead or stay behind where you are on the Academic track of reading/study. Either is fine, the important thing is that you absorb the beauty of the story of Scripture as a whole. The Bible can be read in a year with roughly 20 minutes of reading per day, so that may be a good place to start.

At the end of the semester, be prepared to write a reflection on your readings thus far.

### ACADEMIC

You will do an in-depth factual study of each book. Follow the online course prompts through the outline, quiz, and essays for each book. Quizzes and essays are open-book and open-note.
