SHARE YOUR STORY Storytelling

It's time to put one of your favorite stories on paper. If you have never spent the time to write down that family story that everyone knows, that story about how your church began, or maybe a story from your own experience, then write it down today.

While we often want to tell and re-tell the sorrows of our lives, leaning on the drama or the gossip for dramatic effect, in-sighting guilt, or venting our frustrations, this writing practice is about God's blessings. There is much to be thankful for in remembering the good in our stories just as we have gained from the good of the biblical story. Even though this library of stories in the Bible has many ups and downs, this re-telling brings us the good news of Jesus Christ. It is when we see God at work when tragedy is overcome, when we step back and see the big picture and how God was there through it all and has brought us a long way, it is then that blessings are revealed.

Be prepared to share your story with others. Use this as part of a weekly small-group activity or the children's message during worship. Share it with a professional storyteller or preacher to get help refining it into something to be performed, much like a good sermon or well-crafted comedy sketch.
