LESSON PLANS

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this lesson is again to get them to use "Me gusta..." very often. This phrase is also very useful to them. Remember to practice this in the kitchen while you are looking around the fridge or pantry so they can say what they like and/or not like. Kiddos especially like to talk about their toys, so grab those and ask them which ones they like.
