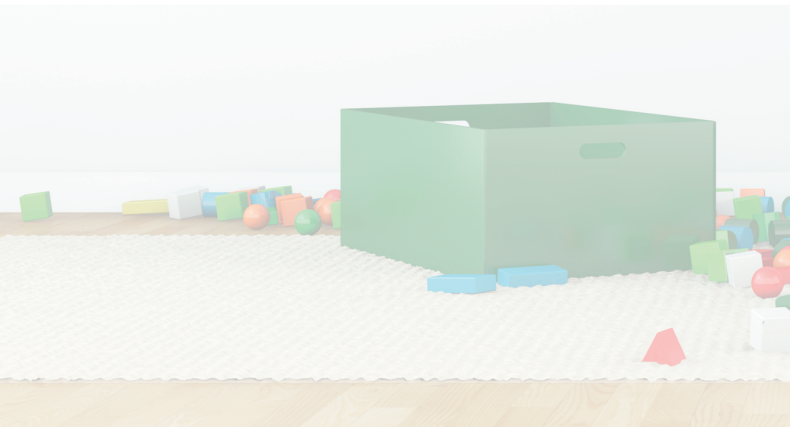


WHY PLAY IS IMPORTANT

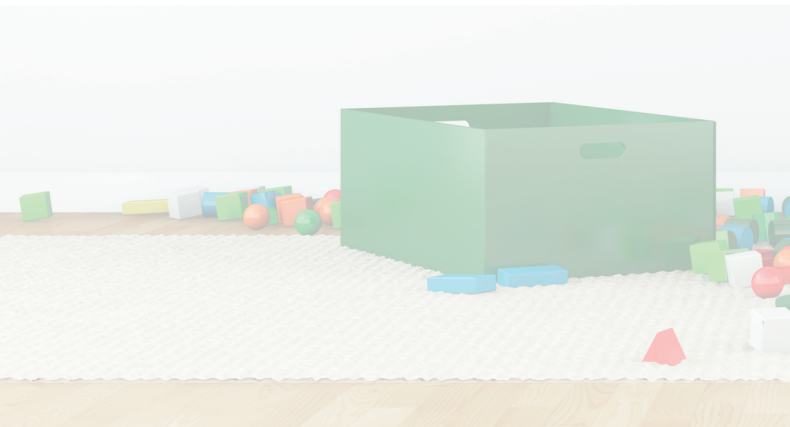


INSTRUCTIONS:

Model behavior - do it together

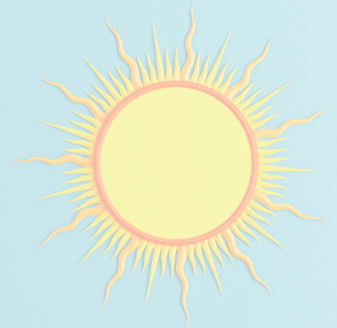
