

Finding lost animals using animal communication

Introduction

Hello and welcome to Finding lost animals using animal communication. My name is Claire Bloomfield and I am a professional animal communicator. This course contains practical tips and advice on how to use animal communication when working on lost animal cases. As well as advice and guidance for those who have an animal missing. I wanted to create this course because I know that many people are interested in learning about it but is one of the most challenging forms of animal communication and most people don't feel they know enough to be of help to others.

Statistics show that millions of domestic animals go missing every year, they estimate that 1 in 3 domestic animals will get lost in their lifetime. As the number of missing animals increases, more of these animal's guardians are contacting animal communicators for help in locating their lost animals. Unfortunately, it can be hard to find a communicator willing to work a lost animal case, as they are notoriously hard and highly emotive. Some people completely avoid working with lost animals, while others will agree to connect with the animal but just once to pass on as much information as they can. Others still, do what is known as tracking, where they connect with the animal on a regular basis, sometimes over a span of weeks or months, trying to pin down the exact area that an animal can be found. In all lost animal cases, it is important to remember that you are not working with just the animal but also with their person and your ability to help the animal depends entirely on the person's willingness and ability to search for the animal and follow what you receive. Lost animal cases are nearly always highly emotive, as the animal is more than likely disorientated, scared and confused and the animal's person can be impatient, hysterical and desperate. Added to this the

fact that the animal may have been stolen, may have died while lost or may have run away on purpose, you have to prepare yourself for the fact that it is no easy task to get an animal returned to her person, no matter how advanced your skills are. That said, with the vast amount of animals who go missing or a stolen on a daily basis I feel it is only right to provide information to help those who do decide to work with lost animals, in the hope that it helps reunite more people with their beloved animal friends.

I have written this course for both animal communicators interested in working on lost animal cases and for anyone who has or may one day have an animal go missing. While it is also possible to use the techniques in the course to help you find your own animal, it is important to note that communicating telepathically with your own animals can be much harder as you have a vested interest in the results. I have designed the course with both the communicator and animal guardian in mind because as an animal communicator it will help you to know what advice the animal's guardian should be following. As the guardian of an animal who is lost, it can help to know and understand how and why a communicator works your case the way they do. My hope with this course is that having everyone working from the same perspective, will make it easier for lost animals to be located and returned to their loving homes, as safely and as quickly as possible.

Working on lost animal cases requires skill as a communicator so this course is for people who already know how to communicate telepathically with animals. You will not find the process here for how to communicate with animals; I have my beginners and Intermediate courses for that. This course specifically covers guiding you to use the skills you already have to work specifically on lost animal cases.
