There are an endless number of ways to "pursue" rest, but there is only One who is 100% true to His promise every single time.



Everything was created through Jesus. If anyone knows humanity, it's Jesus. He created it, but He also became it. He has an out of this world perspective unlike any other.

Jesus the Teacher-

- 1. Are you weary & do you carry heavy burdens? There's an invitation for you to COME.
- 2. "I will give you rest." Rest is something that is received. You don't work for it. You don't earn it. You receive it.
- 3. "Take my yoke upon you." What is the yoke of Jesus? Everything that Jesus modeled in the scriptures stemmed from His relationship with His Father. The foundation of His yoke was His trust & love-driven obedience to His Father. He was committed to fulfill the purposes and plans of His Father. He operated through the power of the Holy Spirit at the pace of grace in order to fulfill those plans & purposes. Everything He did, He did out of love and obedience to His Father even unto death.
- 4. "Let me teach you." He is willing to teach us but are we willing to let him.
- 5. "because I am humble and gentle at heart." Humility and gentleness was foundational for Jesus' effectiveness to teach us rest. I'm led to believe that humility and gentleness must also be foundational for us to <u>learn and live in rest</u>. Pride is absolutely exhausting.
- 6. "for my yoke is easy to bear." Why is the yoke of Jesus easy to bear? We were created by God for God. The Bible says that God lined our hearts with eternity. The yoke of Jesus is easy to bear because it's a perfect fit for the way that He created us. We were created to be in relationship with the Father. We were created to trust the Father and to live a life of love-driven obedience to the Father. We were created to operate through the power of the Holy Spirit at the pace of grace and to fulfill God's purpose and plans on the earth. The yoke of Jesus is easy when living a surrendered life because it was God's original intent.
- 7. "the burden I give you is light." Fear & pride are heavy burdens. What Jesus has given us is an invitation into trust & humility. He has invited us into a life of reliance that leads to rest. As we rely on God, we receive His rest.
