We believe that both boys and girls need programs that are designed for their unique and valuable strengths and traits.



Trail Life USA understands the needs of boys and strives to provide an environment where they can fully be boys so they can develop into winning and confident men.



Starting with the **Woodlands Trail** for grades K-5, boys gain knowledge about outdoor skills, citizenship, character, friendship, and faith through fun activities, awards, and skill instruction.

Navigators, grades 6-8, gain understanding of their values and beliefs under the guidance of godly male role models through being responsible in school life. They explore areas of interest outdoors adventures and in their home and models earn Trail Badges for advancement.



Adventurers, young men in grades 9-12, mature in wisdom and faith through more difficult challenges and leadership activities with Christian men walking alongside them. They plan outdoor events, large projects, and hold leadership positions in the Troop.
