Cheer for your team at one of the world's most famous football stadiums.

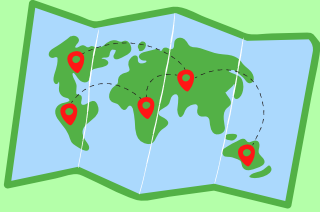

CLASSROOM SUGGESTIONS



Students take on the role of explorer, researcher, and reporter. They can pick a place to visit, learn about its history and culture, and tell their classmates what they discovered.

During each Trip, students will improve their spoken language and work to perfect their pronunciation with AI speech recognition.

Challenge your students to find something in each scene that nobody else has noticed!



Trips range from 5 to 20 minutes, so you can use one to punctuate a lesson, or build a whole class around several experiences, and deep-dive into a topic or spark a debate.



Exploring and learning in Virtual Reality is more tangible than using normal videos. However, to have the biggest impact, VR Trips should be combined with real-world activities to reinforce new language, as well as discussions about what students have seen/heard/learned.

Small groups are recommended, so that each student can use a headset, however there is a variety of different and exciting ways VR can be used in school.



Dynamic Languages will provide lesson plans and can work with teachers to tailor the materials to their needs. We can also provide an expert teacher to lead the class via Google Meet (or similar) if required.
