

Baby Ladybug Main Activity

In this main activity we will be focusing on different grips and grasps
and our bug this week is a Lady bug!

You will need:

- 12 small white round stickers
(Alternative: any round shaped stickers)
- Black paint
- A4 red card board with 6 hearts (see PDF)
- Scissors and Marker
- Tray and Low tub
- Leaves/flowers/garden items



Method:

1. Use our Lady Bug Heart template to print 6 hearts onto red paper or draw 6 hearts onto red paper like the template.
2. Let your baby assist you to place white stickers where the eyes of each ladybug should be (you can also draw this with a marker)
3. Put the marker in your baby's hand and assist them to draw black dots in the eyes with your hand over theirs.
4. Squeeze some black paint onto a tray and let your baby dip their index/pointy finger into the paint. Assist your baby to give each red ladybug some spots.
5. When dry, cut out your lady bugs.
6. Fill a low container with dry leaves and other garden items.
7. Hide your ladybugs under the leaves for your baby to find.

If you don't have red paper, use white paper and colour the hearts in red.



Count the Ladybugs as your Little one finds them! You can also sing your Ladybug song as you play and search for them among the Leaves.
