Repertoire Checklist: Appropriateness

For the Ensemble

- o Is the work age appropriate?
- Can the ensemble meet the expressive demands?
- Can the ensemble meet the technical demands?
- Instrumentation: do you have the instruments/voices & soloists needed?
- Equipment: do you have the physical resources needed?
- Budget: is this piece affordable?

For the Occasion

- How will this piece work in this venue?
 - Indoors vs. outdoors
 - Size of stage
 - Dead vs. live acoustics
- **Resources**: what equipment is available at this venue?
- Does the music suit the type of event? eg. formal vs. informal, graduation, assembly, fair, contest,
- Object the length of the piece suit this performance?
 - How long is your segment?
 - How long is the whole show?

For the Audience

- o Is the audience musically knowledgeable (or not)?
- What is the audience expecting at this event?
- O Do you want to educate the audience?
- How will it be interesting/relevant to them?
- How will they connect with the piece?
- How will the audience experience this piece within the whole program?

For the Conductor

- Can you meet the technical demands of this piece?
- Can you meet the **musical** demands of this piece?
- Can you teach the concepts in this piece?
- O Do you have the tools to rehearse this piece?
- Do you have time to learn what you need to teach this piece confidently?
- Will you enjoy investing time learning and conducting this piece?
