1.	Warm-up	Video	Warm-up Routine I (page 13, MB I)
2.	Review songs	TOR	One, Two Buckle My Shoe, Star Light & Rain, Rain
3.	Listening	Video	Fly Play-along Video – listen and watch only
4.	New song overview	Video/TOR	Get Ready to Play – Fly <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Special effects sounds- G note
5.	Focused practice	Video	Component Practice Video <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Note recognition- Right Hand- Right Hand with special effects sounds
6.	Individual practice	TOR	As needed to get ready for play-along video (PDF of score is in lesson folder)
7.	Ensemble practice	Video	Fly Play-along Video <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Guided class play-through- Adjust tempo as needed
8.	Change of pace/ brain break	TOR	Student solos, games and videos etc. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- the ‘Activities and Videos’ glossary in the Resources folder has ideas and links
9.	Preview song	TOR	Choose any play-along video from Levels 2-5

After completing Lesson 6 students can:

- Read and play the G note
- Change strings with the right hand across three strings
- Recognize repeating patterns in written notation
- Perform Fly including extension techniques
