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Connected Pronoun “My”

We show ownership/possession by adding an ending to the noun.



We add the letter 'yaa' to the noun to say 'mine'

New word	Mine/ My ending	Noun
أُمِّي My Mom	ي	أُمُّ a mom
أَبِي My Dad	ي	أَبٌ a dad
إِبْنِي My son	ي	إِبْنٌ a son

هَذَا ابْنِي.



This is my son.

هَذِهِ ابْنَتِي.



This is my daughter.

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Connected Pronoun "Your"



We add the letter 'kaaf' to the noun to say 'yours'

<u>New word</u>	"Your" Feminine Ending	"Your" Masculine Ending	<u>Noun</u>
جَدُّكَ جَدُّكِ	كِ	كَ	جَدُّ ← a grandfather
جَدَّتُكَ جَدَّتْكِ	كِ	كَ	جَدَّةٌ A grandmother
جَارُكَ جَارُكِ	كِ	كَ	جَارٌ A neighbor

I am your husband.
