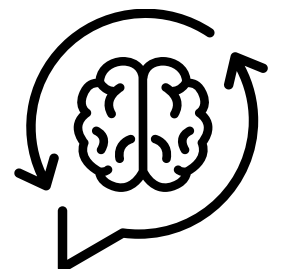
Reverse Translation (orally)

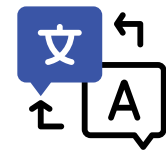
