

REVERB GLUE BUSS AND ADDING REVERB

Creating a reverb glue buss is a great way to bring all of your tracks together with cohesion. It's particularly useful when your tracks have been recorded in different places

Bring up a new buss and add your reverb of choice. Now you can tune your reverb to your taste adding high and low pass filters. A high pass will help to reduce low end and low mid muddy sounds from your reverb whilst a low pass filter will help to reduce harshness.

Experiment with compression and saturation on your reverb to add different flavours to your mix.

EXTRA REVERBS

In this tutorial I've also added some reverb to my backing vocals to send them further back in the mix and used reverb so add extra depth to my guitars

TOP TIPS

Remember to add a send from your busses to your reverb glue buss!

Reverb sounds great but it's really easy to over do it, a little goes along way!
