Heavenly Father-in this new year; please walk through my home, take away my worries, illnesses, & protect my loved ones safe in your hands! In Jesus name, Amen!





Leaders are to <u>serve</u> people but <u>obey</u> God. 1 Corinth. 4 1-5.


LEADERS ARE TO SERVE PEOPLE BUT OBEY GOD.

Seek others to hold you accountable and act as your alarm bells. Gal. 6: 7-10.




LEADERS ARE STEWARDS OF EVERYONE WHO FOLLOWS THEM

Hebrews 3: 17.


ACCOUNTABILITY: LEADERS WILL ENDURE A STRICTER JUDGEMENT

At the judgement seat of Christ we will be required to give an account for what we did with our lives and our influence.






