



Prayer prompts are meant to serve as a springboard to your prayers. Use them to help focus your thoughts and give direction to your prayers as you meditate on the idea of broken cisterns - anything we put ahead of God.

* Lord, show me what it means to love You with my entire being. Teach me to hold nothing back from you. Help me to give you all of my affection, all of my ambition, and all of my loyalty. Help me to recognize when my devotion to You is half-hearted. I want to seek You with my whole heart.

* God, remind me daily of the lengths You've gone to to save me. Help me to serve You, not out of duty, but out of deep gratitude for who You are and what You have done. Strengthen my memory of Your faithfulness so I do not turn to other "gods" that cannot save.

* Reveal to me, Lord, any broken cisterns I have tried to carve out—empty pursuits, false securities, idols of my own making. Show me how forsaking You always leaves me thirsty, weary, and unsatisfied. Bring me back to the fountain of Your living water.

* I know that I cannot serve You and money. Father, search my heart for any double-mindedness. Help me escape the grip of materialism, greed, or financial fear. Teach me to trust You fully as my Provider and Treasure, and to serve You alone with complete allegiance.

* Lord, realign my desires. Help me to invest in eternal things—loving people, building Your kingdom, obeying Your word. Teach me to measure success not by earthly gain or wealth, but by heavenly rewards that will never, ever fade.

* Examine me, God. Wherever my heart clings too tightly to the shiny things of this world, gently pry my fingers open. Create in me a heart that longs more for You, instead of the comforts and possessions this world offers.

* Lord, break my heart over idols that I have allowed into my life. Show them to me, so I can remove them. Teach me to see idolatry as You see it—a betrayal of Your covenant love. Help me repent and renew my commitment to You alone.

* Strengthen my resolve to flee the traps of greed, pride, and selfish ambition. Turn my feet and my heart toward righteousness and godliness.

* Lord, forgive me for the idols I have created, knowingly or unknowingly. Tear them down, and build in me a heart that seeks You above all. Help me to be satisfied by Your living water and never seek a cheap substitute ever again.
