

# **Supply List**

### Snail Mail Quilted Postcard with Rachel Rossi

- · Sewing Machine
- Iron
- Favorite needles for piecing (I prefer <u>Microtex</u>)
- · Self-healing Cutting Mat
- Acrylic Ruler (if you have one with 1/8" markings on it, that's helpful!)
- Rotary Cutter
- Designated Rotary Cutter (or scissors) for cutting paper
- Matching thread (Aurifil or a comparable Cotton Thread)
- Pins
- Washi, Double Sided Tape, or Masking Tape
- Freezer Paper

You can purchase pre-cut freezer paper sheets or a roll.

- 4x6 piece of Peltex UltraFirm Stabilizer or Pellon 71F
- 4x6 piece of backing fabric
- Embellishments

#### Optional but helpful items:

Straight Stitch Plate

## **Fabric Requirements**

A post-card sized project doesn't require much fabric, so scraps are perfect! Make sure to have a good selection of background fabrics, fun shell fabrics, and bodies for the snails. This may vary based on each student, so be sure to surround yourself with beautiful scraps! Please note that all fabrics are assumed to be 100% cotton and non-directional!

- Add-a-quarter ruler
- Binding Clips
