What is a domain?

- A domain is a unique and searchable place on the web where people can find your website.
- The domain is the “plot of land” upon which your website sits.
- A domain *isn't* a website-it is where the website is hosted.

What is a domain?

- Technically a domain is a series of letters and numbers which points to a unique address occupied by your website

Types of domains

- There are numerous types of domains
 - .com
 - .biz
 - .org
 - .me
 - .us
- In all, there are more than 1,500 of these domains in existence

Types of domains

- Some domain types have restrictions the types of entities that can use them
- .us can only be used by residents, citizens, or businesses based in the US.

How to pick a domain name

- Is your business based on YOU (is your name available?)
- What is your core offer or service?
- Who is your core customer and what would they search for?
- Does a potential name make sense?
- What do other people in your market use?

Domain name cost

- Domains vary in cost greatly
- They range from a few dollars to multiple millions
- Companies like godaddy (which I use) can facilitate purchasing and registering your domain.
- remember, you will pay annually for your domain name.

Practical steps

- Type in `www.____.com` to see what comes up
- Google “domain name finder” and use one of the free domain search tools that populate in the search results
- Go to a domain host (like godaddy) to do a search for available domain names.

Which should you use?

- There is no one right answer-but here are a few tips
- It needs to make sense to your customer
- It needs to represent your services accurately
- If you can afford it, get the .com domain as that is still the default domain.

Domain hosting

- There are MANY different domain hosts
 - Godaddy
 - Blue Host
 - Liquid Web
 - Host gator

What is web hosting

- If you want a website you need to rent space on a server to host the data that is your website.
- You are renting “land” for your website
- The domain is the land, and you get it by renting the land from the owner.

Hosting is like renting

- Someone else owns the space where it exists
- Someone else is responsible for keeping the space clean and running
- If you need something updated or fixed you go to the host

Hosting or Buying

- Almost everyone on the internet hosts without buying their own space
- It is cheaper
- It is safer
- Easier to fix when something goes wrong
- Hosting companies have resources you will never have

Types of hosting

- There are four basic types of hosting
 - Shared hosting
 - VPS hosting
 - Dedicated hosting
 - Cloud hosting

Shared

- This is the cheapest hosting
- Think of it like an apartment building
- Numerous people all over the world share one server
- This means that:
 - There are website traffic limits
 - The performance of your website can be impacted by other sites

VPS

- Stands for virtual private server
- This is similar a duplex.
- A physical server is partitioned into individual virtual servers
- There is better quality hosting with more flexibility
- Higher traffic availability
- Allows for additional customization for your specific needs

Dedicated

- You are the only one who inhabits a server
- This is like renting a house
- No sharing
- More customization
- Most expensive
- Most traffic
- No limitations from other people

Cloud hosting

- Everything is hosted virtually, nothing directly tied to physical servers
- Has more flexibility than shared hosting
- Works well if you have fluctuating traffic spikes

Which is best for you?

- Very few people need dedicated hosting
- Get shared hosting to start and move as you get more visitors to your site
- Your hosting company will usually notify you if your traffic is going above your hosting plan

There is no one right answer

- There is no one perfect domain name
- There is no one perfect hosting service or company.
- Pick something and move forward
