Common American names with AIR:

Jared, Derek, Larry, Jerry, Harry, Farah, Mary, Sarah, Terrence, Daryl

eir/ier: weird, pier, tier

Sentences:

The weird man spilled beer in his beard. The wiad man spilled bia in his biad.

Oh dear, your fears are fairly weird.
Oh dia, your fias are fairly wiad.

I peered into my rearview mirror when we got here.

I piad into my riaview miaror when we got hia.

I'll have a seared steak made of deer meat.

I'll have a siad steak made of dia meat.

It's been a weird year here. It's been a wiad yia hia.

oor: door, floor, poor

oar: coarse, hoarse, roar, soar

or: portrait, form, forward, lord, corn, dork, fork, horn, horror, north, order,

orchid, short, story, torn

our: your, four, mourn, pour

igher: higher

ir: iron (i-yearn)

iar: liar, briar

yer: flyer

I ironed the entire collection of retired shirts.

I ara-ned the entara-collection of retara-d shirts.

My tired boss hired and fired me in one day. My tara-d boss hara-d and fara-d me in one day.
