1.	Warm-up	Video	Free Stroke Exercises (p. 75, MB I)
2.	Review song	Teacher Directed	Study in E Minor
3.	Listening	Video	Study in G Play-along Video – listen and watch only
4.	Get Ready to Play	Video	Study in G <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Both the bass and treble voices move - Placing one left-hand finger at a time for some arpeggio shapes helps coordination - The right-hand pattern has some variation now
5.	Component Practice 1	Video	Component Practice Video 1 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Measures 1-4
6.	Individual Practice	Teacher Directed	As needed for measures 1-4
7.	Component Practice 2	Video	Component Practice Video 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Measures 5-6
8.	Individual Practice	Teacher Directed	As needed to get ready for play-along video (PDF of score is in lesson folder)
9.	Change of Pace/ Brain Break	Teacher Directed	Student solos, games and videos etc. the 'Activities and Videos' glossary in the Resources folder has ideas and links
10.	Ensemble Practice	Video	Study in G Play-along Video <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Guided class play-through - Adjust tempo as needed
11.	Summary and Closing	Teacher Directed	Summarize and review the learning targets for this lesson (found below). Close with one more full class/ensemble performance of Study in G.

After completing Lesson 34 students can:

- Place one left-hand finger at a time as needed to help transitions between arpeggio shapes
- Apply changing free stroke patterns in a musical context
- Perform Study in G accurately and with good technique
