These are the notes I'm using for the course. They are skeletal, but this big picture overview will help you see the arc we are building.

MODULE 1. COURSE OVERVIEW & CORE CONCEPTS

Synopsis: Week 1 is a broad overview of astrology in the context of Western Esotericism. We will define the art, outline the major philosophical principles underlying it and address some common antiastrological critiques.

- a. Astrology & Western Esotericism (Technical Hermetica, Pseudepigrapha, Theurgy)
 - 1. Homer via Porphyry ("Cave of the Nymphs"); the Great Bear
 - 2. Plato's "Myth of Er" and Spindle of Necessity
 - 3. Aristotle's Causal Cosmology (Supra- and Sublunary Spheres)
 - 4. Hermeticism (Poimandres I:25; Vices/Virtues; Seven Governors)
 - 5. Gnosticism (Aeons, Archons, Abraxas and the Demiugros)
 - 6. Neoplatonism (Theurgy; Henosis)
 - 7. Mithraism (Tauroctony; Planetary Grades; Anabasis/Ascent through the Spheres)
 - 8. Qabalah (Cosmology of the Tree of Life; Planetary and Zodiacal attributions to the Hebrew Alphabet)
 - 9. Rosicrucianism (Millenarianism/New Age, Stella Nova, Fire Trigon)
 - 10. Freemasonry (Hiramic Tragedy, Tetramorph, Royal Arch)
- b. Orientation and Definitions (Hermetic, Micro/Macro, "Positivistic Arrogance")
 - 1. "The study of the mirroring of celestial events on the terrestrial sphere"
 - 2. Aristotelian/Ptolemaic Cosmology
 - 3. Hermetic Analogy: Astrology is to Astronomy as Alchemy is to Chemistry as Magic is to Technology
 - 4. Positivistic Arrogance (Qualifiability vs. Quantifiability; Enlightenment Critique)
- c. Objectivity vs. Subjectivity (Animistic/Enchanted Worldview vs. Psychological)
 - 1. Animism/Enchanted Cosmos
 - 2. Aristotle and Ptolemy's Causal Model
 - 3. Symbolic (Planets indicate) or Causal (Planets Cause); the Clock Analogy
 - 4. The Psychological Model (Planets as Compartmentalized Components of the Psyche)
- d. Determinism vs. Free Will (Compatibilism as a Synthesis, Stoicism)
 - 1. Astrological Fatalism/Stoicism
 - 2. Astrological Magic as a Mitigatory System
 - 3. Compatibilism (Matryoshka Dolls; the Billiards Analogy; Chronos, Kairos & Aion)
- e. Heliocentrism vs. Geocentrism (Anti-Astrological Argument #1 geo-referential)
- f. Tropical vs. Sidereal & Precession (Anti-Astrological Argument #2 seasonal)
