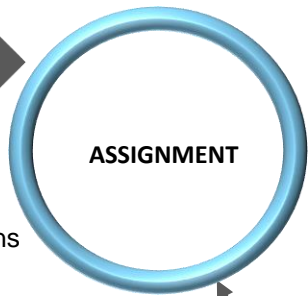
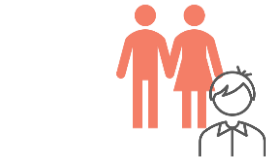


Contract definition
"A contract is a legally binding agreement, that is, one which the courts will recognise and enforce."

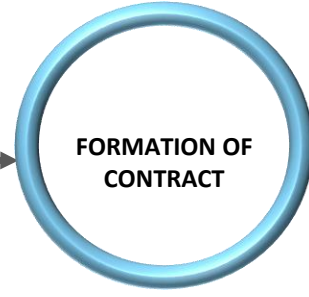
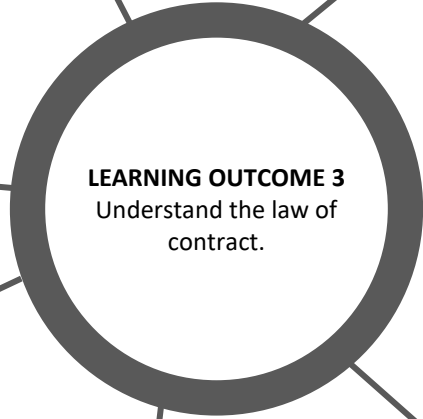

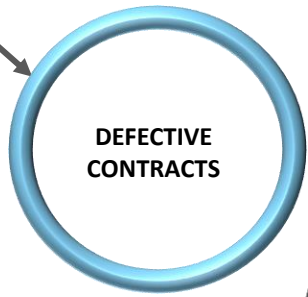
