



- White hot pressed watercolor paper tiles measuring 4x4 inches. I use Fabriano Studio. Bring several to try out different layouts.
- Scraps of watercolor paper to test the color palette.
- Watercolor paints. I use Ecoline primary colors (Lemon Yellow 205, Magenta 337, Cyan 578 ) mixed in a palette or plastic paint tray.
- Thick watercolor paintbrush. I use 10 round brush
- A container with water
- Paper towel
- Fine-liner pens in at least two colors. I suggest Marvy Le Pen in green and pink or red. You can also use Arteza fine-liners, Stabilo fine-liners.
- Watercolor pencils, at least in rust brown and dark green. I use Derwent Graphitint or Albrecht Durer brands. You can also use regular pencils in brown and burnt ochre.
- Brown inking pen. I use Sakura Micron 01 or PN.
- White gel pen. I use Sakura Gelly Roll 10
- Graphite pencil. I use Staedtler Mars Lumograph F.
- White colored pencil. I use white Prismacolor Premier.
- Practice paper or journal
