



- A square paper tile. I use hot pressed watercolor paper, measuring 4x4 inches (10x10 cm) colored with watercolors and distress inks. To save time, you can also use paper that is already colored, either tan, medium blue or lavender. Try repurposing your tiles!
- Optional: watercolors or distressed inks to color the background if you are using white paper
- Black inking pen. I use Sakura Micron PN
- Thick black marker. I use Sakura Micron 10 or Sakura Permapaque marker
- Graphite pencil. I use Staedtler Mars Lumograph F pencil
- Blending stump or tortillion
- Ruler
- Soft white eraser
- A 2x2 inch (5cmx5cm) piece of scrap paper - regular thin paper.
- White gel pen. I use Sakura Gelly Roll 10.
- Gel pens in neon color: I use Sakura Gelly Roll moonlight in orange or pink.
- Matching fineliner. I use Marvy Le Pen finalizers in lavender and pink. You can also use Sakura Micron.
- White charcoal pencil. I use General's White charcoal.
- Colored pencils: I use Caran D'ache Pablo, Faber Castell Polychromos and Prismacolor. Dark colors only: black, dark blue, dark purple, dark magenta. (Or matching colors to your background).
- Optional: medium/dark gray brush marker. I use Copic N2 and N4.
- Practice paper or journal
