I dont fully recommend this brand, it can be quite oily. But if you only have RIOT in your area, they are still totally fine oil paints to use.

Some colours are not available, so you may need to get them in another brand. No pinks or natural greens, and Magenta is really important - so do find that!

The colours are not exactly the same as the **Art Spectrum brand**, but I have chosen as close as I can so you can subsitute the colours where needed.



## Important things to also get:



### MEDIUM Langridge Low toxic, paint medium (odourless)

Low toxicity and completely odourless alternative to traditional oil mediums where exporsere to turpentine may be an issue.

They have recently changed their labels which now do not have the words: "Odourless" on the front, but it is still the same product!

**Constituents:** Stand Oil (40 Poise), Low Toxic Solvent, Alkali Refined Linseed Oil, Cobalt Drier.



#### **PALLETS**

Paper palette pads are usually found in the cheep shops. I usuallly attach a sheet to a thick piece of cardboard with tape. Some people prefer to use a wooden palet, or even glad wrap over a tile! I actually love using glass! (find an old piece of glass from a frame and just put sticky tape around the edges so they are safer)



The red circles is my standard pallet, but the purple squares are a number of extra colours that we are using for online classes plus a bright pink which is not foudn in this brand.
