Life and Labels

I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. Psalm 139:14 (NIV)

Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex!

Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it.

Psalm 139:14 (NLT)

I have chosen this NLT version because of the word "complex".

Maybe you have labelled yourself complex or others have because of your various natural strengths and then of course weaknesses just like me. You wish you could get it right all the time, at least most times!

The first meaning of complex I came across, adjective: **complex**

1. consisting of many different and connected parts.

I have had the opportunity of hearing the word "labels' as to:

How others may label us How we may label ourselves How life may label us How we may label others

Sometimes it may be of a positive nature - godly, good-looking, wealthy and so on.
Oftentimes, it may be of a negative nature - ungodly, ugly, of a lower class and so on.

We all face circumstances and situations in life that may bring about a label.

Others may label us on our looks, intelligence, strengths, weaknesses and so on

We may label ourselves as not confident, not good enough or life may even label us based on circumstances into which we were born or find ourselves in – maybe race, class, family style, and so on.

My thoughts today are: no matter what people, life and ourselves as individuals, have labelled us, let's choose to believe we are who God says that we are!

I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well Psalm 139:14 (NIV)

Very importantly, the last part of the above verse says, I know that full well, my soul knows that full well

How do we get to this stage of knowing - that our soul knows **full well**?

The way to know or believe (have faith) is to speak it to our own hearing (affirm/declare) because the bible says, faith comes by hearing (Romans 10:17)

The Bible also says, we speak because we have believed (2nd Corinthians 4:13).

You see, it's all a cycle - We must speak, then we hear (ourselves), then we believe, then we speak, then we hear (ourselves), then we believe and so it goes.

So, my dearest ones (myself included), from Today, let us speak that which God says concerning us, so that we may hear ourselves, and then believe and BECOME all that He has called us to be in Jesus name, Amen.

This is of utmost importance because not knowing who we are in Christ can give rise to a number of issues such as seeking validation from others, insecurity, a lack of confidence in one or more areas, fear, worry, anxiety, some of which I have personally experienced.

If left unchecked, these feelings or perceptions of not knowing who we are in Christ, can lead to being robbed of our joy, peace, blessings God has prepared

especially for us, and even more, stopping us from living out our purpose and becoming the blessing to others God has created us to be.

But the Almighty God has made a way for us through His word and His son (who is also the word – John 1:1) and so, we will not be defeated!

The issue or problem with labels is that they can become an obstacle, if allowed, to our being, doing, becoming, all that God has called us to do which in turn can rob us of our blessings and the blessings we are to bestow on others.

So, let me ask you?

Who puts and has the ultimate right to label or name a product?

I believe it's the Product's Creator.

This then takes me to my second question - Did I make me, or did you make you? **No** Did others make you? **No** Did life circumstances originally create you? **No**

Then we should never allow any of these - ourselves, others and life label us!

God created You and I, so He alone is the one who has the right to name us.

So, what has God named You and I?

For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)

This happened, long ago, before you were born, before yourself, others or life tried to label you.

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations." Jeremiah 1:5 (NIV)

Your original label was sorted before you were born.

So, let's stick with the ORIGINAL!

Most of us don't like counterfeit labels or products, so why would you want to be or wear a counterfeit label of yourself.

So, what is our label?

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvellous light;

1st Peter 2:9 (NKJV)

We (You and I) are already chosen by the Almighty God!

I want you to know that ONLY your Heavenly Father and Creator has the right to label you.

So, You (and I) will be speaking to yourself, for the next 28 days in different variations, a reminder that despite what we might have labelled ourselves, others have called us, or life has labelled us, **We are Who God says We Are!**

I HAVE GOD'S POWER

Each time he said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness." So now I am glad to boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ can work through me.
2 Corinthians 12:9 (NLT)

As long as you are human, you have a weakness, two or more :-)

There is a tendency for us to focus on our weaknesses, judge ourselves and our worth based on these weaknesses.

But God is saying, guess what? Do you want my Power at its best? The Power of the most high God?

Well then, His power operates at its best in those weaknesses.

His grace - loving kindness and mercy are all you need and are always available to you no matter the situation.

A Quick Note:

Never let what you perceive to be your imperfections get in the way of God's power working through you!
His grace is all you need and has been made available to you.

SPEAK THE WORD:

God's mercy and Loving Kindness are all I need and have been made available to me for every situation.

I take these weaknesses in my stride and allow God's Power to work at its best through me in Jesus name, Amen.

YOU ARE VALUABLE

Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Luke 12:7 (NIV)

Keep me as the apple of the eye; Hide me in the shadow of Your wings Psalm 17:8 (NIV)

SPEAK THE WORD:

I AM VALUABLE TO GOD

I am the apple of God's eye

God does NOT forget even a single one of the sparrows,

How much more Me-

Who is worth more than many sparrows to God!

God has not, will not and will never forget me because He says so in His word.

The very hairs on my head are numbered NOT just counted!

I am valuable, because God says so!

GOD IS FOR ME

"What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?" Romans 8:31 (NIV)

Today, I just wanted to remind You and I, that GOD IS FOR US!

I am further reminded that Because of "His Love", that is Better (greater, stronger, Superior to) than any of life's circumstances (good or not-sogood) - I Will Praise Him.

SPEAK THE WORD:

Praise the Lord! He is good. God's love never fails.

Praise the God of all gods. God's love never fails.

Praise the Lord of lords. God's love never fails.

Only God works great miracles. God's love never fails.

With wisdom he made the sky. God's love never fails.

The Lord stretched the earth over the ocean.

God's love never fails.

He made the bright lights in the sky.
God's love never fails.

He lets the sun rule each day. God's love never fails. He lets the moon and the stars rule each night.
God's love never fails.

Stepping into one of the boats, Jesus asked Simon, its owner, to push it out into the water. So he sat in the boat and taught the crowds from there.

Luke 5:3 (NLT)

When God asks to use the gifts, talents, time and resources that he Has deposited in us for His glory, He is asking to come in, and use our boat.

Seasons change, economies change, but God never changes - and that is Why it's best to have Jesus in our boat.

Today, You and I may have many reasons why we may think we are not suitable for God's use, but If God is asking, then let Him in.

A fisherman called Simon Peter allowed Jesus to come in, and use his boat over 2,000 years ago,

SPEAK THE WORD:

I use them to God's glory
I allow the Holy Spirit work through me to be a Blessing
I am God's representative on earth, in my industry, family and community, in Jesus name, Amen.

I AM GIFTED

For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.

Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching;

he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

Romans 12:4-8 (NKJV)

In his grace, God has given us different gifts for doing certain things well.

Each one of us has been given unique gifts to be a blessing to others. It is unique because no one else can do it exactly the same way you do!

Have you discovered your unique gifts in the place of prayer and practice (for example, trying things out and being aware of what you are good at)?

1 John 4:4 (NIV)

Let us be reminded Today that the Greater One (there is absolutely none, greater)
Lives in You and I And because of this, we have the promise of being overcomers in every situation.
No, not by our own strength, but because of He who lives in us,
Praise the Lord!

He is greater than every challenge, circumstance, obstacle or situation, so therefore we overcome and win in Jesus name.

SPEAK THE WORD:

No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:39 (NLT)

SPEAK THE WORD:

I belong to Christ I speak to my Body, Soul and Spirit and to every circumstance and situation that I AM CHRIST'S!

I (place your name here) belong to Christ. So therefore anything that cannot stand against Christ, will not, and cannot stand against me in Jesus name, Amen.

GOD MAKES ALL THINGS NEW

"But forget all that— it is nothing compared to what I am going to do. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?

I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert. Isaiah 43:18-19 (NIV)

The scripture says that what God is asking us to forget - it is "nothing"! Zero! Nada! Zilch! NOTHING! in comparison to the new thing He is going to do in your life, and mine.

In other words, it does not matter, has no bearing, on what He, Almighty God will do. Hallelujah!

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

God has Plans for You
Those plans are plans of good and not evil
Plans of peace
Plans of prosperity
Plans to give you a future of success,
The Success you hoped for.

Take time out:

In Prayer, Reading the Bible, Listening to Christian Messages, Journaling - to find out God's Plans for your life He has some good plans for You.

Once God starts to speak to you about these plans,
Ask Him for the Grace and help to walk according to the plans,
And then walk in them.

SPEAK THE WORD:

Lord, I thank you that your Plans for me are of good, of a future of success, Plans for my well-being, Not Plans to harm me but Plans to Prosper me.

I receive the grace to know and walk in your plans for my life, So that I will have the future of success I hoped for, in Jesus name, Amen.

No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us. Romans 8:37 (NLT)

Whatever situations we face, God says that we have overwhelming victory - meaning NOT a small amount, but a great amount of Victory!

Through who do we have this victory?

Through Christ who loved us!

Whatever you face today, Pray to God that he will give you overwhelming victory in the face of the challenge or situation, according to His word.

Speak victory,

Listen to Christian messages that declare victory,

Begin to believe God for overwhelming victory through Christ who loves you.

SPEAK THE WORD:

Father, I thank you for overwhelming victory in the face of every challenge I face, I say and believe that I have victory because of Christ who loves me Thank you Lord!

I AM FULL OF VALOUR

And the Angel of the Lord appeared to him, and said to him, "The Lord *is* with you, you mighty man of valour!"
Judges 6:12 (NKJV)

There was once a man called Gideon.
One day, an angel appeared to him and called him - a mighty man of valour and how he would lead his nation to victory against their enemies.

Gideon first explains to the angel of God about how his "clan is the weakest" and he is the least member of this "weak clan"!

Gideon finally took up the challenge of leading his nation to war (after much convincing) and in the end, indeed led them to victory as God had said.

We come to see it in the scriptures that indeed Gideon had it in him,

to be a mighty man of valour but didn't see it in himself, but God, Our Father and Creator did.
