You can print as many of these pages as you need, and feel free to write more notes than you think is necessary.

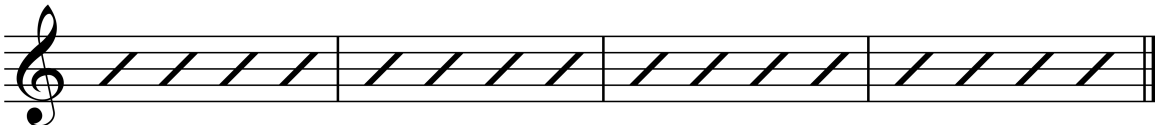
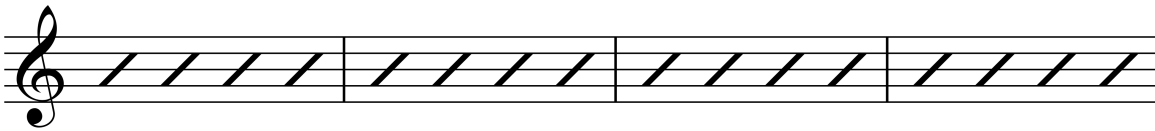
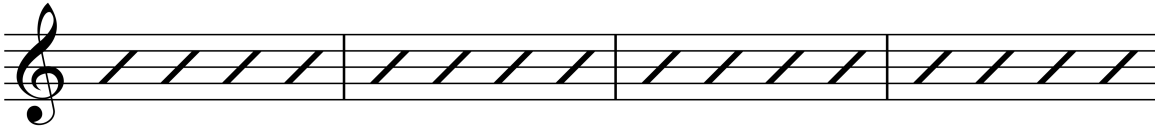
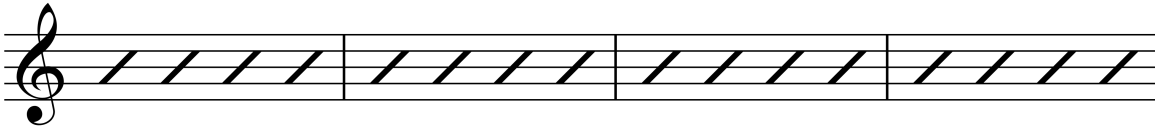
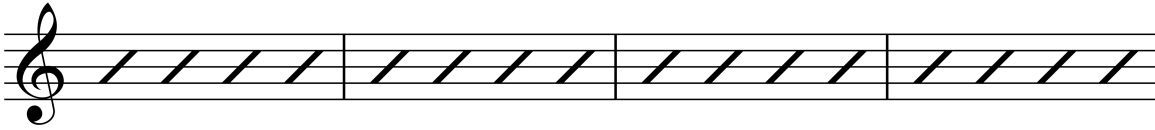
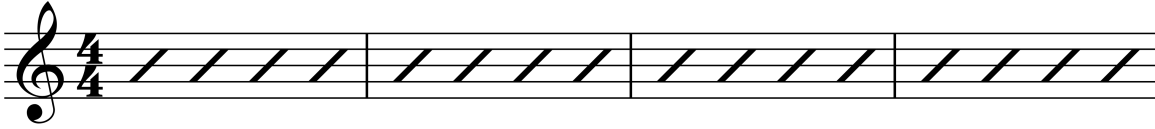
Note taking is important in the guitar learning process, so these sheets allow you to keep notes and write out exercises in the woodshed.

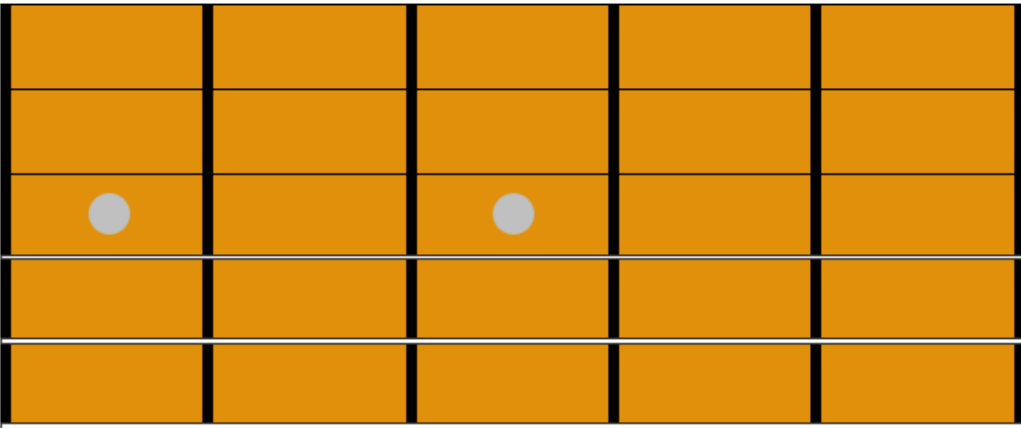
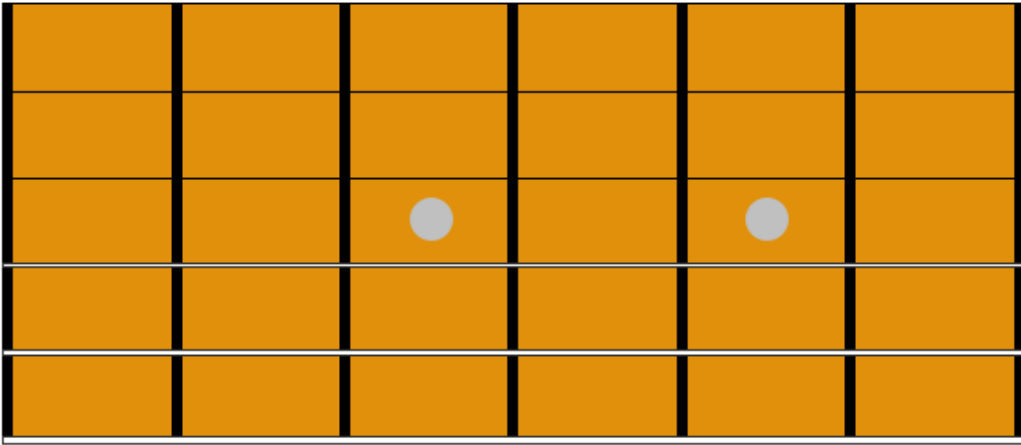
