

In the Old Testament the Spirit of God dwelt upon His people. This is referred to as the 'upon ministry', where the Spirit would rest upon particular people for a particular period or mission.

Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the Lord came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

1 Samuel 16:13

In the New Testament, as learned in this module, Jesus' promise of the Holy Spirit coming to dwell in those who accepted His gift of salvation came to be.

And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:3-4

Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. John 14:17

Mary
