* Father, I am a planner! I like to know exactly when and how things will work out. Help me surrender my timeline to You. Even when I don't understand Your timing, help me to trust that You are working all things for my good.

* Lord, teach me the difference between waiting patiently in faith and waiting impatiently in frustration. Help me to rest in Your unshakable promises instead of striving and struggling in my own strength.

* God, in the seasons of waiting, help me to wait quietly and confidently for Your salvation. Calm my impatient heart and teach me to trust in Your goodness even in the waiting.

* Lord, sometimes I get so discouraged by the evil and wickedness in the world. I look forward to the day when Christ returns, and all things will be made new. Help strengthen my hope in heaven.

* Father, help me to stay faithful in prayer, serve others, and grow in Your Word while I wait. Let me be found working for Your kingdom when you return.

* God, when someone wrongs me or someone I love, help me to trust You as the righteous judge. Help me to resist the temptation to seek justice on my own. Help me to try to overcome evil with good by doing good to my enemies.

* Father, please help me to keep my focus on eternity. The world around me is so real and it's easy to focus on the here and now, rather than on eternity with You. Help me long for Christ's return.

* Lord, I know that loving parents discipline their children. Even though Your discipline is painful in the moment, I trust that it is for my good. Help me use Your correction to shape me into the image of Your Son. I want to become better for you, not bitter towards you.
