Please note this is a list of supplies but you can add more or work with less.

- Paint brushes, large and small
- Acrylic paints, artist, or craft quality
- A few Small spray bottles
- Water container
- 1 tub of baby wipes
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 10 paper plates, for palette
- **Optional, some and not all-aqua pencils, Wax water-soluble crayons, pastels, colored pencils, charcoal pencils etc.
- Ephemeral-buttons, ribbons, small bits of material, feathers, small beads,
- Fun fibers or found fibers, yarns etc.
- Thread-thicker or thinner, Waxed Book Thread
- Needles-small and larger with points-Crewel works best.
- Optional-the use of a sewing machine.
- Watercolor paper 140lb. Hot press (2) sheets 14 x 18
- A few sheets of drawing paper 9 x 12
- Cheese cloth
- Rusty bits or rusty baking sheet
- Coffee filters,
- Vinegar in a spray bottle with water, ½ and ½
- A plastic garbage that will fit your pan
- Aluminum disposable pan, 12 x 10 x 3
- Small pot with lid (we will burn paper in it, I purchased on from Goodwill)
- Hibiscus tea, or blueberry tea- (to add to rust dyeing)
- Marble
- India ink
- Coffee-Brewed
- Matches
- String
- Jar of Soft Gel Medium
- Jar of Gesso 8oz.
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Bone tool
- Large zip lock bag
- 1 days' work of newspaper
- Plastic dollar store table covering.
- Found papers, and found photo's resale shops have them
- 1 photo of yourself 2 x 3 inches to use in your scroll. Can be a computer copy.
- Black plastic clips or clothes pins to help hold things in place.
- Sticks, dowel rods,
- Painter's tape
- Thin material like sheets.
