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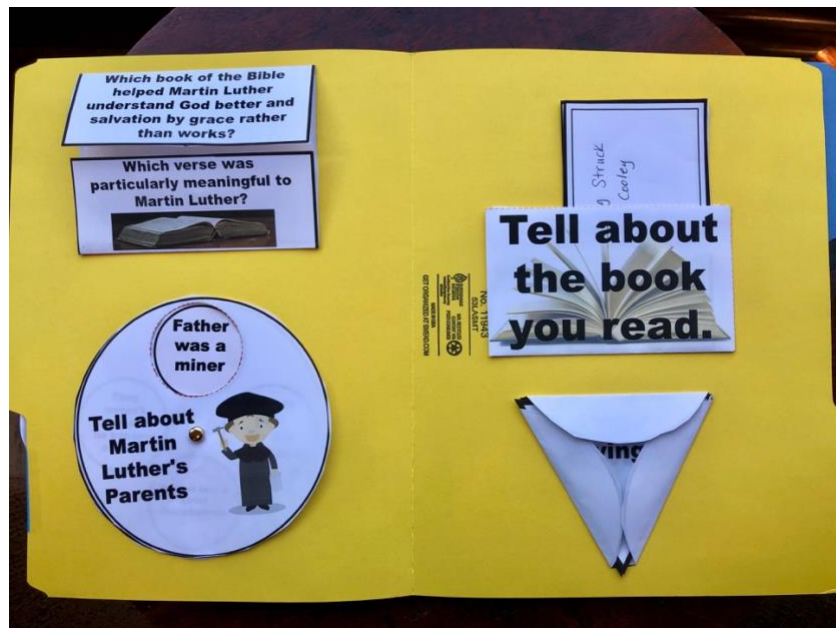

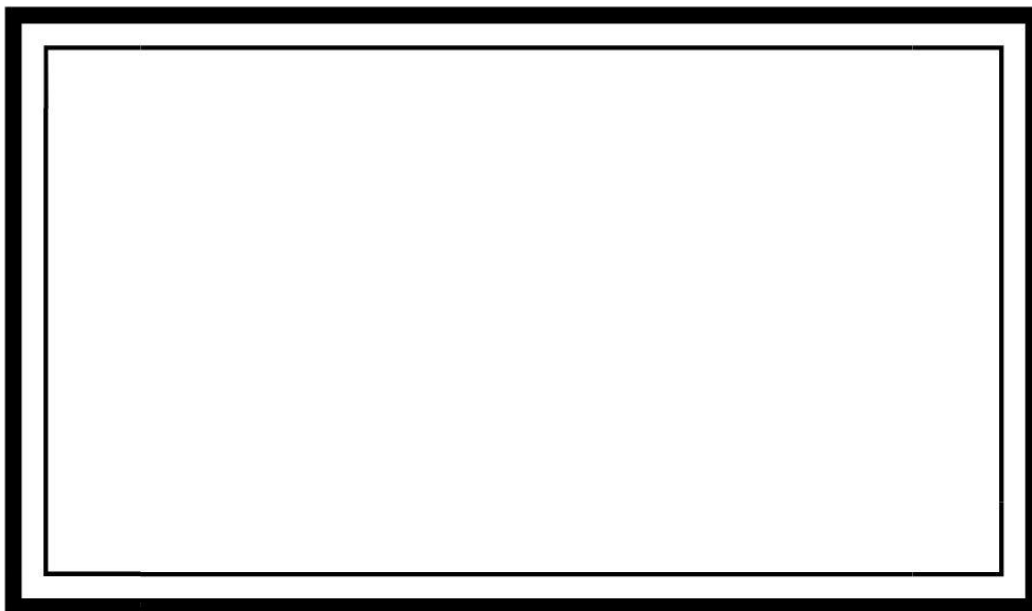
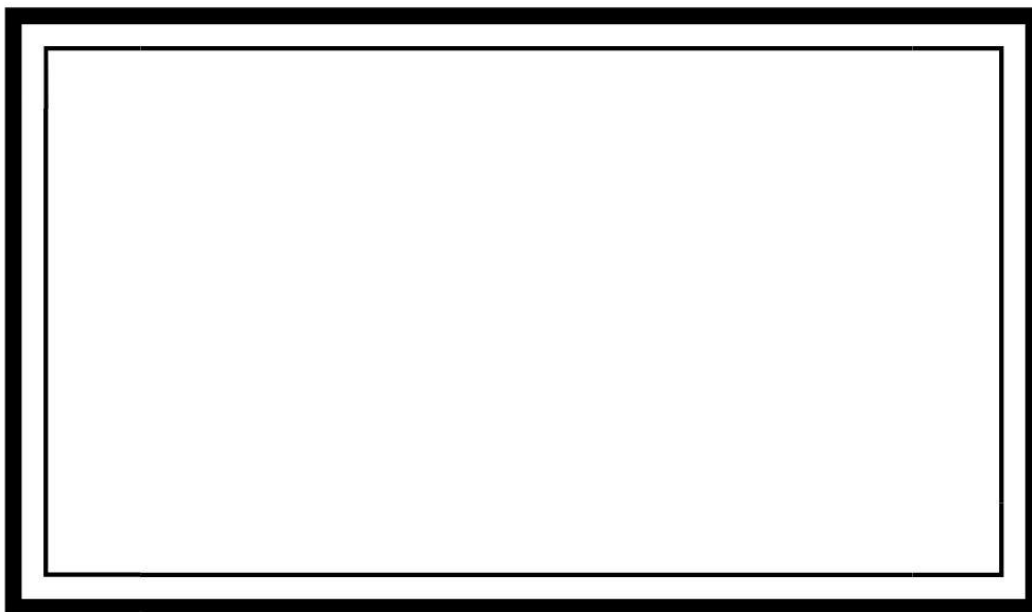
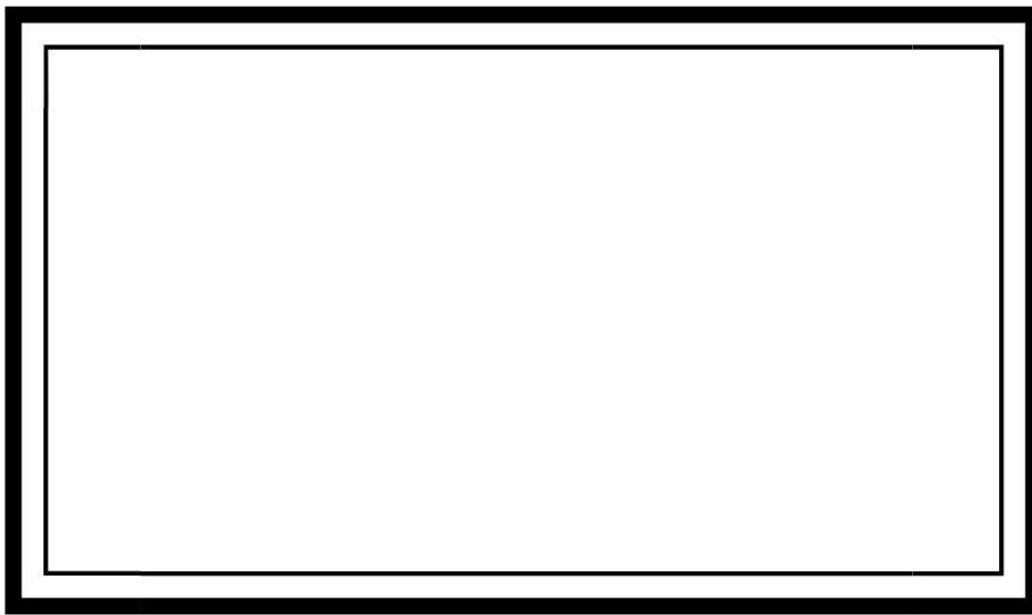
○ Indulgences are meaningless, and they give the people false hope of getting into heaven, as well as stealing money from them.
