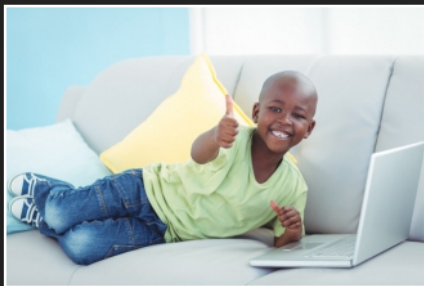

 Punya

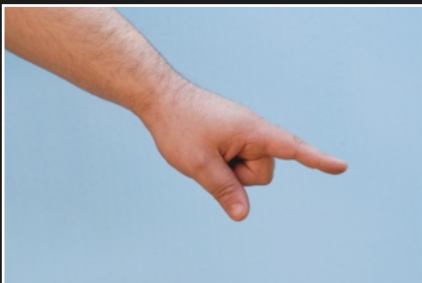
Do you have a car?
