### Tips for Adjusting and Changing the Scrap It Now Layer Style Manual

Change the stroke outline and drop shadow of the photo clipping masks to best fit your scrapbook page and your personal tastes.

Note: The complex photo clipping masks should never have a stroke outline or drop shadow applied.

- Open a template (File > Open).
- In the Menu Bar, choose File > Duplicate and click OK. (PS: Choose Image > Duplicate.)
- Close the original file.

#### **Load the Scrap It Now Frame Styles**

If you need help loading the Scrap It Now frame styles, you'll find step-by-step PDF instructions in the classroom.

#### **Change the Drop Shadow**

- In the Layers panel, double click on the layer style icon of the layer you want to alter.
- In the dialog box, click on Drop Shadow, change the Size, and click OK.

Note: If you choose to use one of the ScrapItNow Frame Styles, you will need to alter the size of the drop shadow after applying the frame style.




### Change the Size of the Stroke Outline

- In the Layers panel, double click on the layer style icon of the layer you want to alter.
- In the dialog box, click on Stroke, change the Size, and click OK.



### Change the Color of the Stroke Outline

- In the Layers panel, double click on the layer style icon of the layer you want to alter.
- In the dialog box, click on Stroke, then click on the Color Chip to open the Color Picker.
- In the Color Picker, choose a new color or sample one from the document, then click OK to close the Color Picker.
- Click OK to close the Style Settings dialog box. (PS: Click OK to close the Layer Style dialog box.)




### Remove the Stroke Outline

- In the Layers panel, double click on the layer style icon of the layer you want to alter.
- In the dialog box, uncheck Stroke and click OK.



### Use a ScrapItNow Frame Style

- In the Layers panel, click to activate the photo clipping mask layer you want to alter.
- In the Styles panel (Window > Styles), open the dropdown menu and choose ScrapItNow-Frame-Styles. (PS: In the Styles panel, click to twirl open the ScrapItNow-Frame-Styles folder.)
- Click on a style icon to apply it to the layer. To choose a different style, click a different icon.
- To alter the applied style, in the Layers panel double click on the layer style icon of the layer you just altered.
- In the dialog box, change the drop shadow or stroke size settings and click OK.
