I am teaching you how to grow colorful succulents because I am several steps ahead of you in this hobby. I've been through your struggles, and I completely understand where you are now.

When I started with this hobby, my succulents were mostly green.

Don't get me wrong.

Succulents are beautiful even when green. Some of them are more beautiful when green and are better that way.

But some can become unbelievably colorful when stressed.

And that is what we will pay much attention to in this workshop.

As I grew my collection and kept on creating arrangements, I was eventually able to achieve their vibrant colors. I was so thrilled when it happened, but I couldn't consistently achieve the same result. I couldn't pinpoint what exactly caused them to change colors.

The settings are mostly outdoors, in the garden, with actual plant examples to help you better understand the lesson.

In my succulent journey, I started growing succulents that were mostly green, but, now, I’m able to grow a lot of colorful ones too. I’ve figured out, step-by-step, how to transform them from their green state to their vibrant colors, and how to maintain their colors if they already started that way.

Every lesson in this workshop is essential and builds on top of the other. So try to do each one in order and do not jump ahead. Try to absorb each lesson, and practice what you’ve learned.
