We look at Winnie Dunn's Sensory Processing Model to help us to understand characteristics of SPD.

#### Sensory behaviours

We explore in depth the word 'behaviour' in relation to SPD and understanding some of the characteristics we might observe.

It's important we know why someone is displaying a certain sensory behaviour, as it will help us to understand specific needs. This can help us to support them better in their day to day routines.
