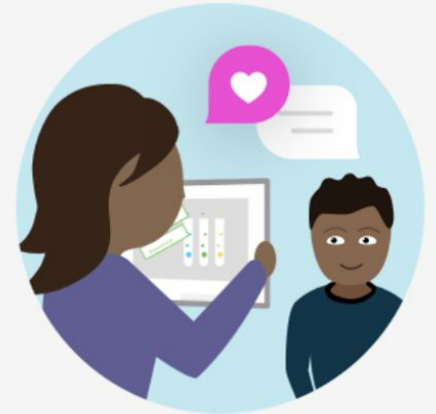
How does Seesaw work?

Teachers get valuable insights into what students understand without extra work





