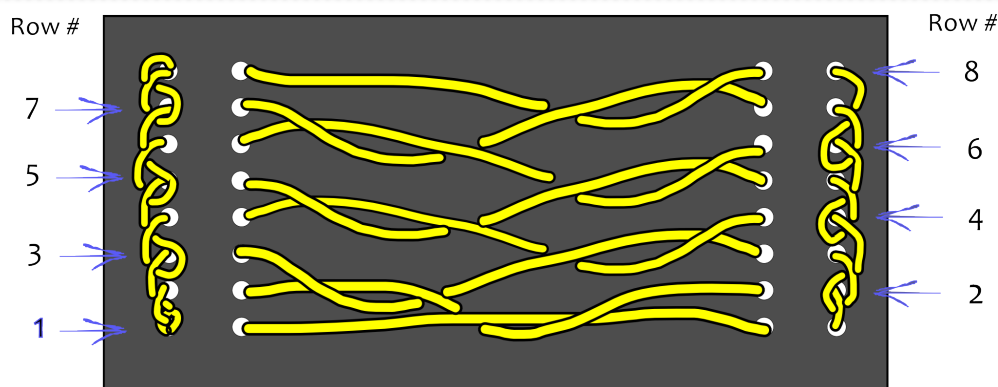


CREATE ARTFUL JOURNALS: Binding Instruction Guide

French Link Stitching Diagram



French Link Instructions

ROW	Instructions
1	Stitch straight across
2	Link around row 1 stitch (center)
3	Link around row 2 stitch (on L side- or side nearest to the station just exited)
4	Link around row 3 stitch (on R side- or side nearest to the station just exited)
5	Link around row 4 stitch (on L side- or side nearest to the station just exited)
6	Link around row 5 stitch (on R side- or side nearest to the station just exited)
7	Link around row 6 stitch (on L side- or side nearest to the station just exited)
8	Link around row 7 stitch (on R side- or side nearest to the station just exited)

NOTE: Diagram at top shows kettle stitch on either end of French link stitch, although this stitch may be combined with a variety of other stitches. Instructions above describe only the center area stitches (the “French link” stitches) after needle exits the signature and before it re-enters the next station. Refer to project videos for 1st and last row instructions for integrated and/or cut-away cover designs.
