Deal with (type 3)

to take action about something

- We need to deal with the bins. They smell!
- Could you deal with all these emails today?

Throw away (type 2)

to put something in the bin

- Could you throw away that food please?
- She threw away all the old toys.

Carry out (type 2)

to do a piece of work

- She carried out research into heart disease.
- They will carry out a survey to see what people think.

Get into (type 3)

to be accepted to a university etc

- She got into Oxford.
- Do you think he'll get into the school?

Go ahead (type 1)

to start to do something, often after waiting

- Please don't wait! Go ahead and eat.
- I think you should go ahead and quit your job.
