

# Lesson 2 - Numbers

## LESSON PLANS

### OBJECTIVE

The objective of this lesson is to memorize numbers 1-10 and then use these numbers in very short phrases. They may not know what every word in the phrase means, and that's fine, it will give them a chance to remember numbers.

### TIMELINE

This lesson can also be looked at and practiced for 2 or 3 days of the week so the kids can memorize the numbers. You can separate the Speaking Cards, the Worksheet and the Song on different days after you review the numbers. But I recommend you start playing the song from the get-go. ALSO: Don't forget to loop around and review Lesson 1 phrases once in a while. :)
