



## **Makes Two (2) Paper 'Festiva Maxima' Peony**

- \_\_\_\_\_ 22g cloth covered stem wire 18 inches (10 pieces)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 180g Green Italian Paper (two pieces 25cm x 25 cm)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 180g Yellow Italian Paper (two pieces 10cm tall x 30cm long)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 60g White Italian Paper/ White Dennison may be subbed (one roll 50cm x 2.5m)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Ruler/Straight Edge
- \_\_\_\_\_ Clear glue (you may sub other glues with varying results)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Scissors and Wire Cutters
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bamboo skewer (2 pieces, for stems)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Medium mixing bowls (for drying the peony bases)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Small bowls for organizing petals
- \_\_\_\_\_ Alcohol ink in a dark pink (I used Tim Holtz Wild Plum)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Modge Podge Matte Sealing Spray, Modge Podge in a pot

*Note: I used yellow paper with white for this particular variety of double peony. There are several variants to the colors. The key is to use colors that would look good together in a when picking your base and petal papers. A blush/white for example would drastically change the coloration of this flower, as would any other color combo! Think also of red with red, peach with peach, etc. - the variations are endless.*
