Community or group meetings

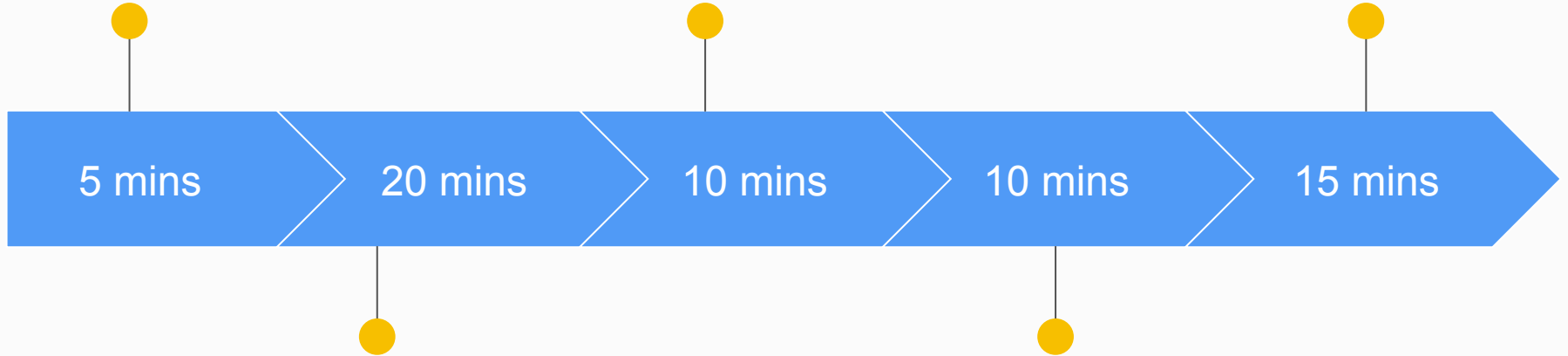
Faith based organizations or groups.
