### **Cluster Recipe 4 - Stacked Tag Cluster**

#### **Tag**

- Shadowed
- Avoid tags with strings

#### **Patterned paper**

- Clips to the bottom tag layer
- Small, all-over pattern

#### **Fastener**

- Shadowed
- Examples: staples, ties, buttons, clips, tape, stitches

#### **Sticker-style element**

- Shadowed
- Small

### **Additional Guidelines for Recipe 4**

- All elements should connect at the fastener.
- Resize the patterned paper so that the pattern is more easily seen.
- Use the same kit for all parts of the cluster.
