- Watercolor Magic (Sargent Art or any other brand)
- Regular Acrylic Paints (Any brand)
- Metal Acrylic Paints (Any brand)
- Acrylic metal inks ("Daler & Rowney FW" or any other brand)
- Brushes, various sizes, flat and regular
- Metal dry pigments (any brand)
