Ladybird Number Plates



7 - Antenae




Fortune Teller

These fortune tellers are so much fun! 1. Ask an adult to help you fold one using the steps below.









Fortune Teller


- 1. Shut your eyes and point to a sound.

- 7. Get ready, go!






