You see parallax effects a lot on the web. This is where a background image stays in place while other content scrolls over it. In this lesson, you'll learn how to add a parallax effect.

The sailboat image begin by selecting the frame that contains a sailboat. Next choose Interactive Widgets > Parallax Background from the in5 menu. There are just three simple options here. Obviously, select the top option to turn on the parallax effect. This next option should be checked since you're using Desktop Scaling for your in5 output. If you were not scaling the output, you'd want to leave this unchecked. Note that if you hover over this field, you get a reminder about what this is. The last option lets you choose Container or Content. This would let you use an image that's larger than the container for the parallax effect if you wish.

Choose Container for now. That's it. Go ahead and export again and preview the results. Really nice! Creating parallax effects within5 just takes a couple of clicks.
