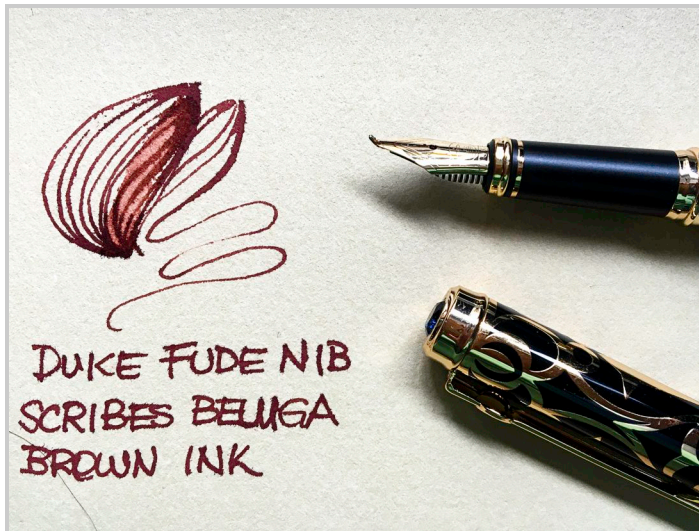




- One BROWN brush pen or Fude nib pen. If you have none, then use a fine point round paintbrush (#0 or #1) with brown watercolors. My favorites are marked with a star. You only need one! From the left to right:
 - Faber Castell Pitt Artist Pen Indian red
 - ★ • Crayola Brush Mahogany
 - Marvy Le Plume II No. 6 Brown
 - ★ • Duke Fude Nib Fountain pen with brown fountain pen ink. I use Scribes Beluga Brown ink (the ink is sold separately)
 - Marvy Le Pen Flex Brown (but is more like purple)
 - ★ • Tombow Fudenosuke Brown
 - Manuscript 1.0mm Italics fountain pen (get brown ink separately)
 - Sakura Pigma Brush Brown
- Brown Inking pen. I use Sakura Micron 01 Brown.
- Tan Tiles. I use Zentangle Phi tiles. You can also use any tan colored paper.
- A water brush or paintbrush with water container.
- White gel pen. I use Sakura Gelly Roll 10.
- White charcoal or pastel pencil. I use General's White Charcoal.
- Graphite pencil. I use Staedtler Mars Lumograph F.
- White colored pencil. I use white Prismacolor Premier.
- Colored pencils: brown (burnt umber), light orange, reddish orange, light magenta and dark purple. I use Caran D'ache Pablo, Faber Castell Polychromos and Prismacolor. You can also use watercolor pencils if you like.
- Practice paper or journal

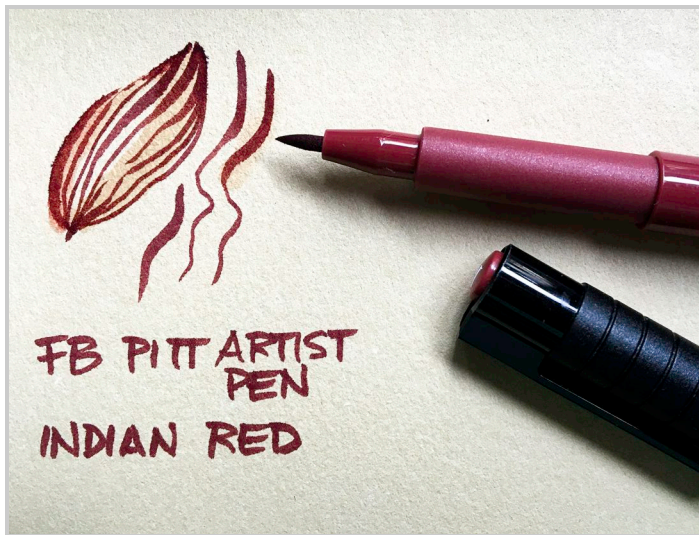
