## Digital Scrapbooking Mastery, No. 1 Shadowing Lesson 5: Patterned Paper Ribbon for PSE Manual © 2019 Jen White

- Begin in Expert Mode of Photoshop Elements.
- Open the scrapbook page (File > Open) that you created in this class.

### Get a Selection Outline

- In the Layers panel, click on the Patterned Paper Ribbon group to activate it and then click on the arrow to twirl it open.
- Hold down the Ctrl key (Mac: Cmd key) and click on the layer mask of the pattern fill layer to get a selection outline around the ribbon.

### Play the Action

- Click on the pattern fill layer to make it active.
- In the Actions panel, click on the arrow to twirl open the Custom Shadow Action group.
- Click on the arrow to twirl open the Custom Shadow Action tasks.
- Click on the Make Layer task to activate it.
- Click on the Play icon.

- In the dialog box, click Stop.

### Transform the Shadow

- In the Layers panel, the custom shadow layer should be active.
- Press Ctrl + (Mac: Cmd +) to zoom into the bottom portion of the paper ribbon. To reposition the zoom, hold down the Space bar and click and drag on the document.
- Get the Rectangular Marquee tool.
- In the Tool Options, click on the New Selection icon. Set the Feather to 0 and the Aspect to Normal.
- On the document, click and drag a selection outline around the bottom portion of the custom shadow.
- Press Ctrl T (Mac: Cmd T) to get the Transform options.
- On the document, hold down the Ctrl key (Mac: Cmd key) and click and drag the lower-right corner handle of the bounding box slightly to the right.



- Click the checkmark to commit.
- Press Ctrl D (Mac: Cmd D) to deselect.
- Press Ctrl 0 (Mac: Cmd 0) to zoom out.
